WHAT IS THE PYRAMID MODEL?

The Pyramid Model is an evidence-based framework that emphasizes teaching essential social-emotional life skills. Every Child Thrives is investing in scaling up this proven model, training and coaching more participating childcare centers. Most

centers work 3 to 5 years to achieve fidelity, where Pyramid Model practices are used consistently—all teachers, all the time.



WHY INVEST?

Quality early learning experiences lay the foundation for lifelong wellbeing. Nearly 90% of brain growth takes place during the first five years of life. This "brain architecture" is formed through a child's interaction with caregivers. Studies show later success in school and life depends on the early development of cognitive

abilities and social-emotional life skills like communication, self-regulation and problem-solving.

MORE CLASSROOMS ACHIEVED PYRAMID MODEL QUALITY BENCHMARKS


Ongoing training, coaching and support helped a growing percentage of Pyramid Model classrooms in moving the needle on Benchmarks of Quality, showing movement toward fidelity.

CHILDREN IN PYRAMID MODEL CLASSROOMS SHOW GREATER READINESS FOR KINDERGARTEN

Data from Dodge and Jefferson Counties shows that children receiving early care and education in Pyramid Model classrooms showed greater competency across measures of developmental readiness in all categories except gross motor skills (where they showed equal competence).

Developmental Screening

WHY INVEST?

Screening helps families unlock critical knowledge about their child's development. Timely developmental screenings are key to identifying developmental delays early, when intervention can have the greatest benefits. Every Child Thrives is investing in the capacity of partner agencies to conduct screenings universally, adopt classroom practices to promote optimal development, and connect families to local resources.

1,312 screenings conducted in 2022-23

Every Child Thrives partners conducted 1,312 screenings over the 2022-23 school year, helping to proactively identify children's needs and connect families to resources.
