

2020 **water** bottle refill station **grants**

Purpose

The Greater Watertown Community Health Foundation's (GWCHF) mission is to inspire collaboration, mobilize resources and encourage innovation that measurably contributes to the wellbeing of our community.

In an effort to help schools create healthy learning environments, our Water Bottle Refill Station Grants will ensure every school in our service area has at least one station installed. These grants will provide funds needed to purchase one (1) water bottle refill station and will only be granted to schools without one.

Who Can Apply?

Grants are available to support public or private schools in the following school districts: Dodge land, Hustisford, Ixonia, Jefferson, Johnson Creek, Lake Mills, Waterloo and Watertown.

Grant Value

Water Bottle Refill Station Grants are valued up to \$2000 to allow for the purchase of one (1) station.
